

LPIC-1 101-400 – Lesson 12 – Lab

- * Join your Lab environment as root
- # cat /proc/partitions # have a look at disks and partitions
- # fdisk -l # show partitions with sizes.
- # mount # see all actual and virtual filesystems
- # mount | grep '\dev' # see filesystems attached to devices
- # ls -la /mnt # is it empty?
- # mount /dev/vda15 /mnt # mount the EFI filesystem to /mnt.
The actual number may differ. Check the previous mount command
- # mount | grep '\dev' # see filesystems again
- # ls -la /mnt # is it empty now?
- # find /mnt # find everything under /mnt
- # cd /mnt # change into /mnt
- # umount /mnt # unmount /mnt. Did it work?
- # mount | grep '/mnt' # still there?

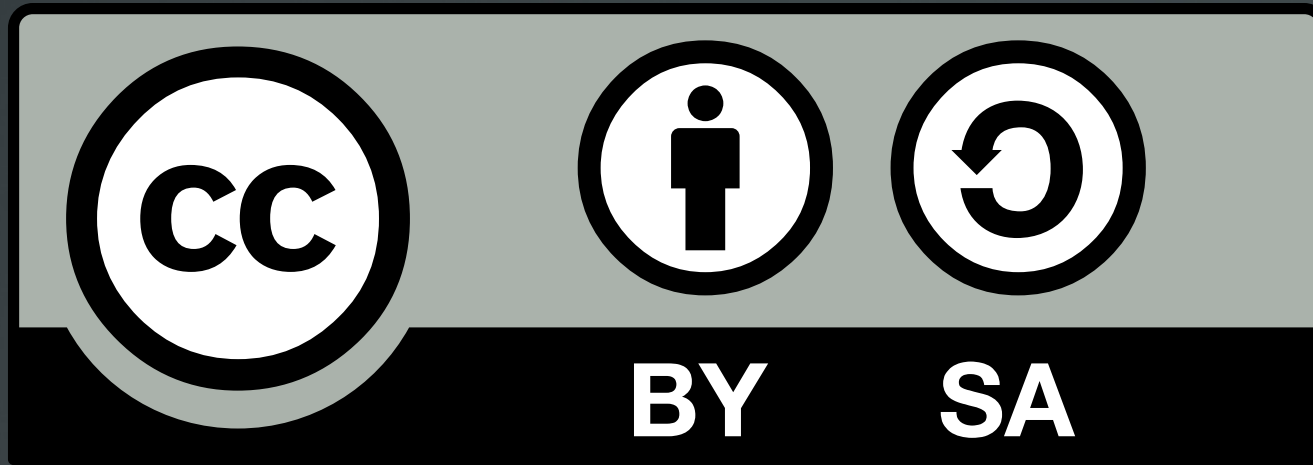


Lesson 12 – Lab

- `# df -hT` # see filesystems with disk usage and filesystem type
- `# cd -` # switch to the previous directory
- `# umount /mnt` # try unmount /mnt now
- `# df -hT` # did it work?
- `# free -m` # check out memory and swap space
