. :w! \# does it work now?
- u \# undo the changes
- :wq! \# force save and quit
- \$ vi poem.txt \# open the file for editing
- G \# go to the last line

- o \# enter Insert Mode after the current line. Enter some text.
- Esc \# escape Insert mode
- ZZ \# save and exit
. \$ vi poem.txt \# open the file for editing again
. :set number \# enable line numbers
- 16j \# go 16 lines downwards
- k \# go one line up
- d1j \# delete current line and the one below it
" :q! \# exit. Do not save changes
. \$ view poem.txt \# open the file for viewing. Confirm changes
- :q \# exit

. \$ vi poem.txt \# open file for editing

- /[Aa]nd \# search for 'And' or 'and'
- n \# find next match. Keep pressing 'n' until the end
. :\%s/[Aa]nd/so/gc \# replace '[Aa]nd' with 'so' and confirm each replacement
- yy \# copy the current line. (make sure you don;t copy an empty
- :set number \# set line numbers
- :14 \# go to line 14
- p \# paste the line below the cursor
- gg \# go to the first line
- dd \# delete (cut) line under cursor
. 3dd \# delete (cut) line under cursor and 3 more
- :20 \# go to line 20
- cc \# cut current line and enter Insert Mode. Enter some text


## Lesson 8 - Lab

- Esc \# escape to command mode
- p \# paste last copied line
- 3p \# paste last copied line 3 times
- :30 \# go to line 30
- :w poem-new.txt \# save your changes in a different file
. :e poem.txt \# load content from original file into buffer. Did it work?
- :e! poem.txt \# force load content from original file into
- :wq \# save and exit vi
